

Dear Neighbour,

My name is Chris Basey and I wanted to write to introduce myself as a candidate in the Cheshire West and Frodsham Town Council elections happening here in May. I have never been overly interested in politics, but when a vacancy came up in my home town, I saw a real opportunity to do something for the benefit of Frodsham.

I worked at Sainsbury's for 34 years before taking redundancy three years ago. Since the first Covid lockdown I managed the opening of a Covid Testing Centre in Chester and helped run a local Covid Charity right here in Frodsham. While doing this, I saw our community pull together like never before and realised how much our town has to gain if we can continue that beyond the pandemic.

-I will work with the Town Council to push for better recreation and play facilities across the board for children and young families.

-And we need better transport links, not just to Liverpool and Manchester but in and out of Frodsham to end the chaos on the A56.

For the last 20 years I have lived in and loved this town. Now I want to make it an even better place to live, work, and raise a family.

If you lend me your vote on May 6th, I will work hard for you, I will make myself available to you and I won't let you down.
